Bobette has been working as script-writer, production consultant and development consultant for several major production companies and networks (Columbia, HBO, Morgan Creek, and others). In Italy she has been working as a teacher and a consultant for Lux Vide and Cattleya. 4/6 original scripts or treatments will be selected to be the object of the course studies.

A maximum of 10 extra partial participants will be possibly admitted to the first two days of class of analysis and development during the course.

- as authors of the scripts or treatments that will be object of evaluation and development during the seminar activities:
- as **non-author participants**, who will likewise follow all lectures and take part in all development activities as well as in the workgroups;

All scripts or treatments submitted shall be written in English. One printed copy shall be sent together with the application form for the seminar selection.

All seminar activities will be held in English.

For selection purposes, it is allowed to submit a script written in Italian or Spanish; however such script shall be accompanied by a letter in which the authors commit themselves to provide an English version of the script by September 11, 2017 - in case their work is selected.

In 10 days time, selected applicants will receive confirmation of their enrolment (be it as authors or as story-editors) which must be completed by **July 10, 2017** under payment of a further fee.
